Acts 2:1-12 New International Version (NIV)

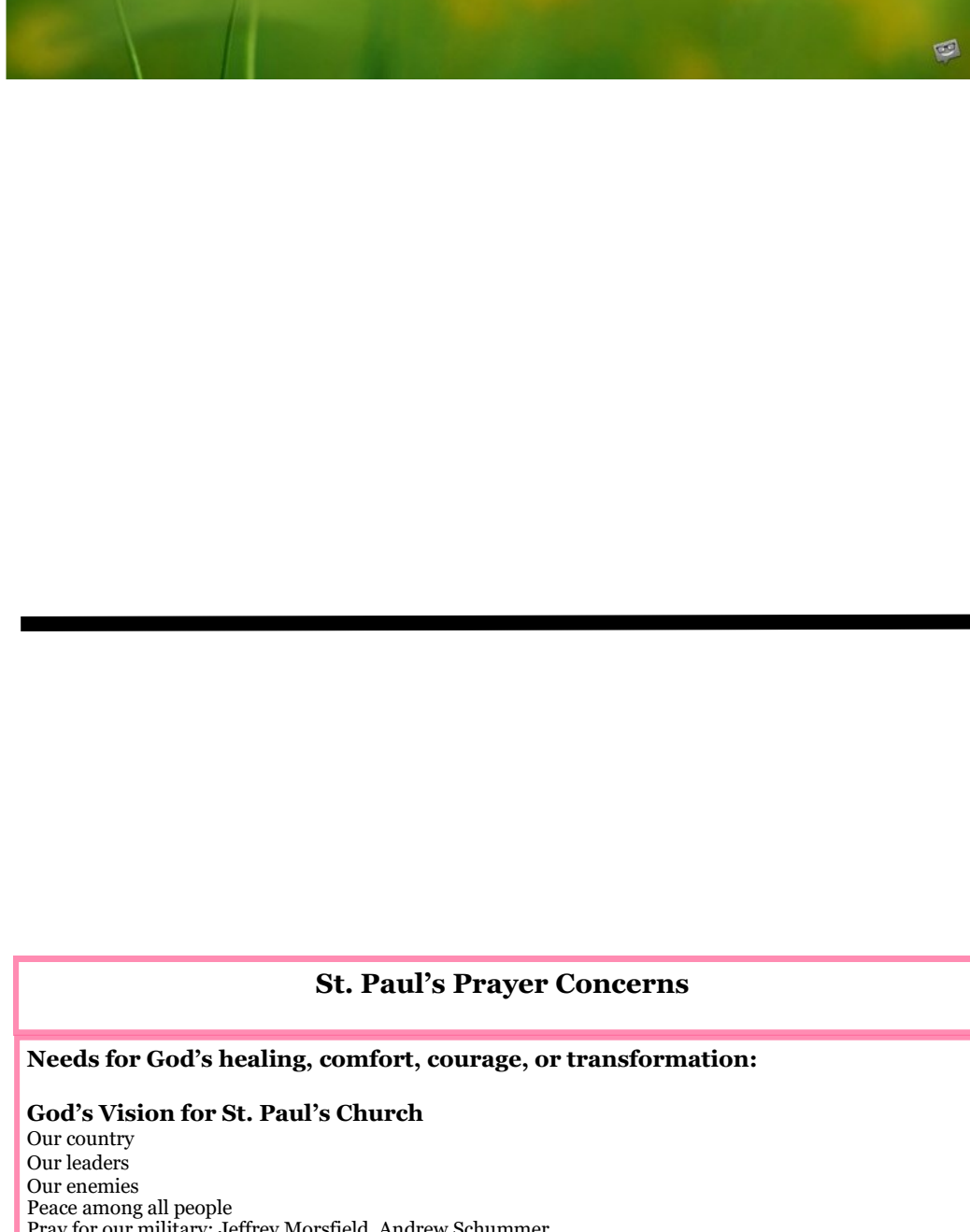
The Holy Spirit Comes at Pentecost

2 When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. **3** Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. **4** They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. **5** All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues ^[a] as the Spirit enabled them.

6 Now there were staying in Jerusalem God-fearing Jews from every nation under heaven. **7** When they heard this sound, a crowd came together in bewilderment, because each one heard their own language being spoken. **8** Utterly amazed, they asked: "Aren't all these who are speaking Galileans?" **9** Then how is it that each of us hears them in our native language? **10** Parthians, Medes and Elamites; residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, ^[b] Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya near Cyrene; visitors from Rome **11** (both Jews and converts to Judaism); Cretans and Arabs—we hear them declaring the wonders of God in our own tongues!" **12** Amazed and perplexed, they asked one another, "What does this mean?"

13 Now listen, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money." **14** Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. **15** Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that." **16** As it is, you boast in your arrogant schemes. All such boasting is evil. **17** If anyone, then, knows the good they ought to do and doesn't do it, it is sin for them.

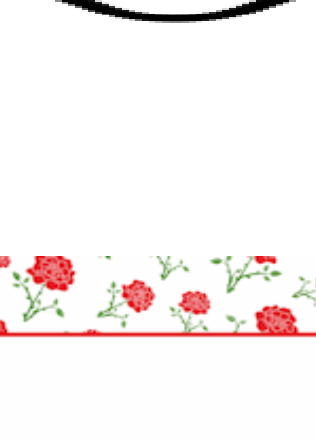
